

Key Points:

- Deadly fentanyl remains a growing threat to the lives of people across Texas and the United States
- Fentanyl is 50 times more potent than heroin and 100 times stronger than morphine
- Mexican drug cartels strategically manufacture and distribute the drug disguised as painkillers, stimulants, anti-anxiety drugs and even candy
- Since 2021, Texas has seized over 544 million deadly doses of Fentanyl (enough to kill every man, woman and child in the United States and Mexico combined)
- In as little as 2 minutes, fentanyl poisoning can end a person's life
- 2mg of Fentanyl is a lethal dose (less than 2 grains of salt)
